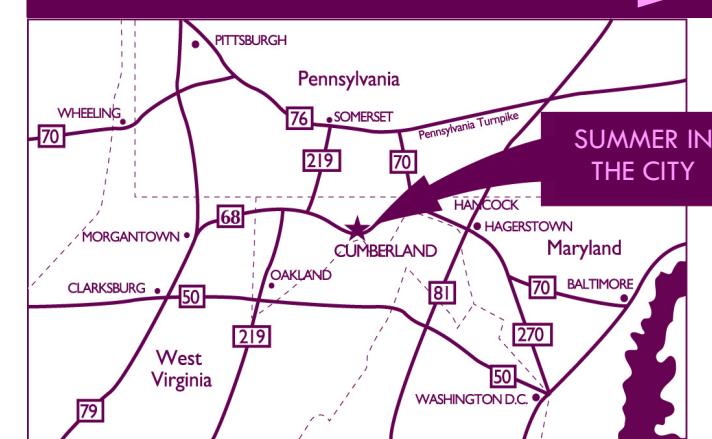
RESTROOMS

TO CONSTITUTION PARK:

I-68 Exit 44. Travel south on Willowbrook Road 1.4 miles to Williams Road and turn right. The entrance to Constitution Park is less than a mile ahead on the right.

TO DOWNTOWN CUMBERLAND: TOWN CENTRE & CANAL PLACE

I-68 Exit 43-C. Turn left at bottom of exit ramp. (Those traveling eastbound on I-68 will be on Queen City Drive; go to the first traffic light and turn left onto Harrison Street. Those traveling westbound on I-68 will be on Harrison Street after turning off the exit ramp.) Ample street parking is available Downtown, parking garages are located at Frederick Street and South George Street, and parking is available at Canal Place.
