All proposals must be submitted in duplicate in a sealed envelope, plainly marked on the outside thereof, "**HENDERSON AVENUE BRIDGE - TRUSS BEARING REPLACEMENT - CITY PROJECT NO. 22-08-BR**", and addressed as follows:

This project includes the replacement of the truss bearings on the west abutment of the bridge over Franklin Street and the CSX railroad.
