Sealed proposals addressed to the Mayor and City Council will be received at the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, Cumberland, Maryland, until but not after 2:00 p.m., local time, Wednesday, May 19, 2010. Proposals will be publicly opened and read at 2:30 p.m. on that date in the Council Chambers at City Hall. All proposals must be submitted in duplicate in a sealed envelope, plainly marked on the outside thereof, "**HENDERSON AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS - CITY PROJECT NO. 11-09-M**", and addressed as follows:
